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Certificate ceremony performed at Varanasi & Chandauli under SANKALP RPL

Synopsis

SANKALP RPL is a pilot project which is initially executed in 2 districts of Uttar Pradesh that are Varanasi and Chandauli. Training and Assessment for this project has been accomplished and now it has culminated with certificate ceremony wherein CSDCI is disseminating certificate, Marksheet, Skill Card, RPL badge and Job role kit to the certified candidates.

Certificate ceremony has been performed for the job role- Mason General L4 at Prathmik Vidyalaya Uperwar Sevapuri, Varanasi. A total of 21 certified candidates of Batch id- 230590 from TP- Deepam contractors pvt ltd have been awarded with certificate, marksheet, Skill Card, RPL badge and Job role kit.



Implementation of RPL-4 under PMKVY 3.0 to be started soon

Implementation of RPL-4 under PMKVY 3.0 is expected to be started soon. 4 Best in Class Employers (BICEs) which are L&T, JMC Projects, B G Shirke and PSP Developers have been onboarded under this scheme. Orientation of 35 Employer's assessors have been conducted for these 4 BICEs.

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WhatsApp and NSDC launch Digital Skill Champions Program

The National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and WhatsApp announced on 24'th of June 2021 that they are partnering to launch the 'Digital Skill Champions Program' that aims to train India's youth on digital skills, in order to make them employment ready.

NSDC and WhatsApp said through this programme, school and university students would be coached to imbibe digital and online skills that would culminate with WhatsApp and NSDC awarding a 'Digital Skill Champions' certification to these students.



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Skills Ministry looks to widen the scope of apprenticeships

Educational and other training institutes will be able to hire apprentices as the government looks to widen scope of the definition of establishments under the Apprenticeships Act. The skills development ministry is likely to move the bill to amend the Act in the monsoon session and will seek cabinet clearance on the proposed changes soon.

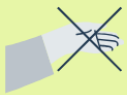
Work is being fast tracked to finalise changes to the Apprentices Act to make it more holistic and aspirational to enable more youth to take up apprenticeship.

Currently, apprentices are allowed largely in the manufacturing sector. The definition of establishment needs to be changed to include any place where trade or commerce or industrial activity takes place, including educational and training institutions.

Use **video conferencing** instead of face-to-face meetings

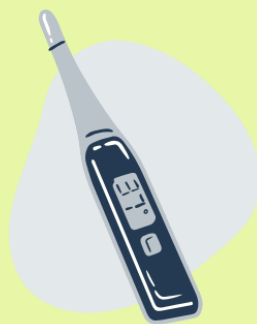
When video calls are not possible, hold your meetings in **well-ventilated rooms and spaces**
